

Signing up for a temporary **Sawyer Free Library eCard** is easy and gives you access to more online resources than you can imagine! Follow the steps below to get started and check out the second page for a list of SFL's online resources.



To Sign Up for a temporary Sawyer Free Library eCard:

- 1 Go to www.sawyerfreelibrary.org on your computer, tablet, or smartphone.
- 2 Look for the COVID-19 Updates section near the top of the website, underneath the catalog search bar.
- 3 Click on the hyperlink titled "register for an eCard".
- 4 Fill out the registration form completely.

NOTE: If you're using an email address provided by your school, it will cause an error when you try to register for an eCard. You **must** have an email address to complete the registration. Create a free email address through Gmail [here](#).

- 5 Click "Submit Registration" at the bottom of the form and you're ready to start using your SFL eCard! The following page will have a list of online resources that you can access immediately.

eBooks, Audiobooks, & eMagazines:



Overdrive can be used on PCs, tablets, and smartphones (including a wide range of older eReader devices by connecting to Amazon for free).



Libby provides free access to the same eBooks, Audiobooks, and eMagazines as Overdrive in a more tablet-/smartphone-friendly interface.

Video & Music Streaming



Hoopla provides access to video and music streaming, as well as some eBooks and audiobooks. Users can download up to five items a month, with exceptions made for select items for a limited time.
